Other News

Ground License & Insurance

We are still having trouble with our license with the Crown Estates, so we have now gone to a solicitor to see if we can sort it out. As it is written at the moment, whoever signs the document will be personally liable for anything that happens to the woods, and so we are trying to find out if the club can become a small, non profit making company, so no individual is in the firing line.

Remember the following important points that affect the club's insurance:

1. Please ensure that you have a club parking permit on display in your car at all times, while you are in the woods.
2. You must have your current COS and NFAS membership cards with you at all times in the woods.
3. You must not take anyone into the woods who is not a club member. Short term membership is available at £10 per month, plus the mandatory £10 for annual NFAS membership.

Any member not rejoining this year should ensure that their padlock key is returned to Carol. You will then receive your deposit back.

Finance

You will be pleased to know that we have raised nearly £1,000 towards buying new targets, thanks to your generosity! Keep it up, and we can have a first class ground this year.
